is granted a permit to perform sewer system renovations at the Bridge City Center landward of the right descending Mississippi River levee, vicinity of second order levee station 465+00, at Bridge City, Louisiana, in Jefferson Parish.

This permit is issued provided the following requirements are complied with:

- 1 All work is to be performed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Office of Coastal Protection and Restoration and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (see Letters of No Objection from Office of Coastal Protection and Restoration and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, attached).
- 2 The work is accomplished in accordance with applicant's letter dated 3/1/16 and accompanying typical drawings.
- 3 Construction must begin within 6 months after request is approved, or a request submitted to this Board for an extension of time. Applicant must notify this office when construction work will begin. Before the start of any work covered under this permit, notice shall be given to the Levee District 72 hours in advance by contacting the Permits Group at (504) 371- 6863 or Permit@slfpaw.org
- 4 Applicant and his surety assumes all cost of proper maintenance and upkeep relative to the facility herein permitted.
- 5 That should changes in the location or section of the existing levee and/or river, or in the generally prevailing conditions in the vicinity be required in the future in the public interest, the applicant shall make such changes in the project.
- 6 The applicant agrees to indemnify and save grantor harmless from any and all liability, including liability of grantor to applicant, its heirs, successors, and/or assigns, arising out of and/or incident to the rights herein granted. Applicant further agrees to appear and defend any and all suits instituted against this Board arising out of and/or incident to this permit, and to pay in full any judgment rendered against this Board arising out of and/or incident to the granting of this permit.
- 7 This permit is valid for a period of one year. A request for renewal should be submitted to this office prior to expiration.
- 8 In addition, it is required that a copy of the permit be kept on site.
- 9 Applicant is advised that any damage to the levee as a result of applicant's activities shall be repaired at applicant's expense and to the satisfaction of the Levee District.

- 10 That no sub-surface excavations or penetrations greater than 18 inches are performed when the Mississippi River attains or exceeds +11.0 feet NAVD 88 on the Carrollton Gage at New Orleans, without prior documented approval to the contrary from the Department of the US Army Corps of Engineers, New Orleans District.

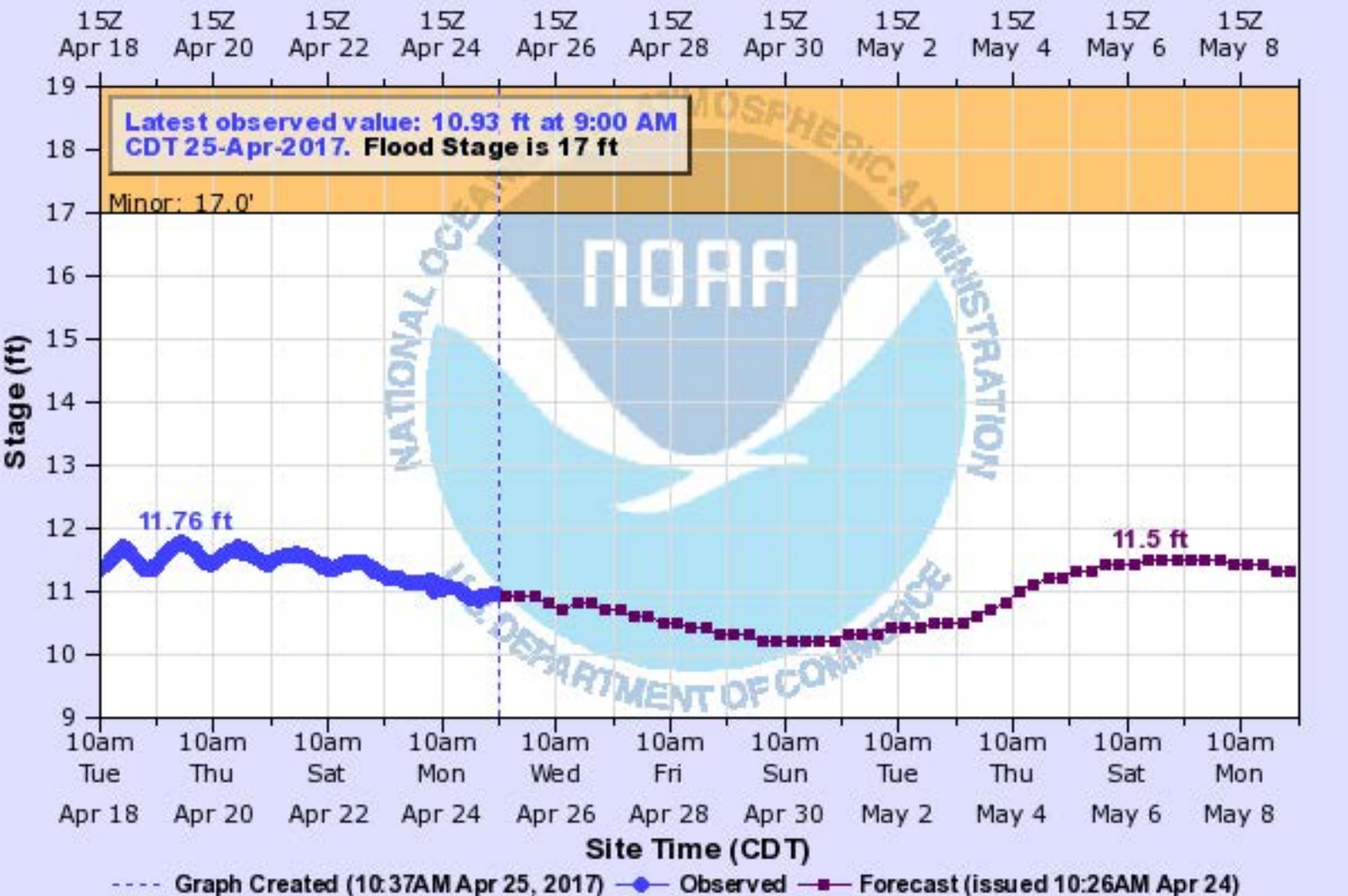

MISSISSIPPI RIVER AT NEW ORLEANS

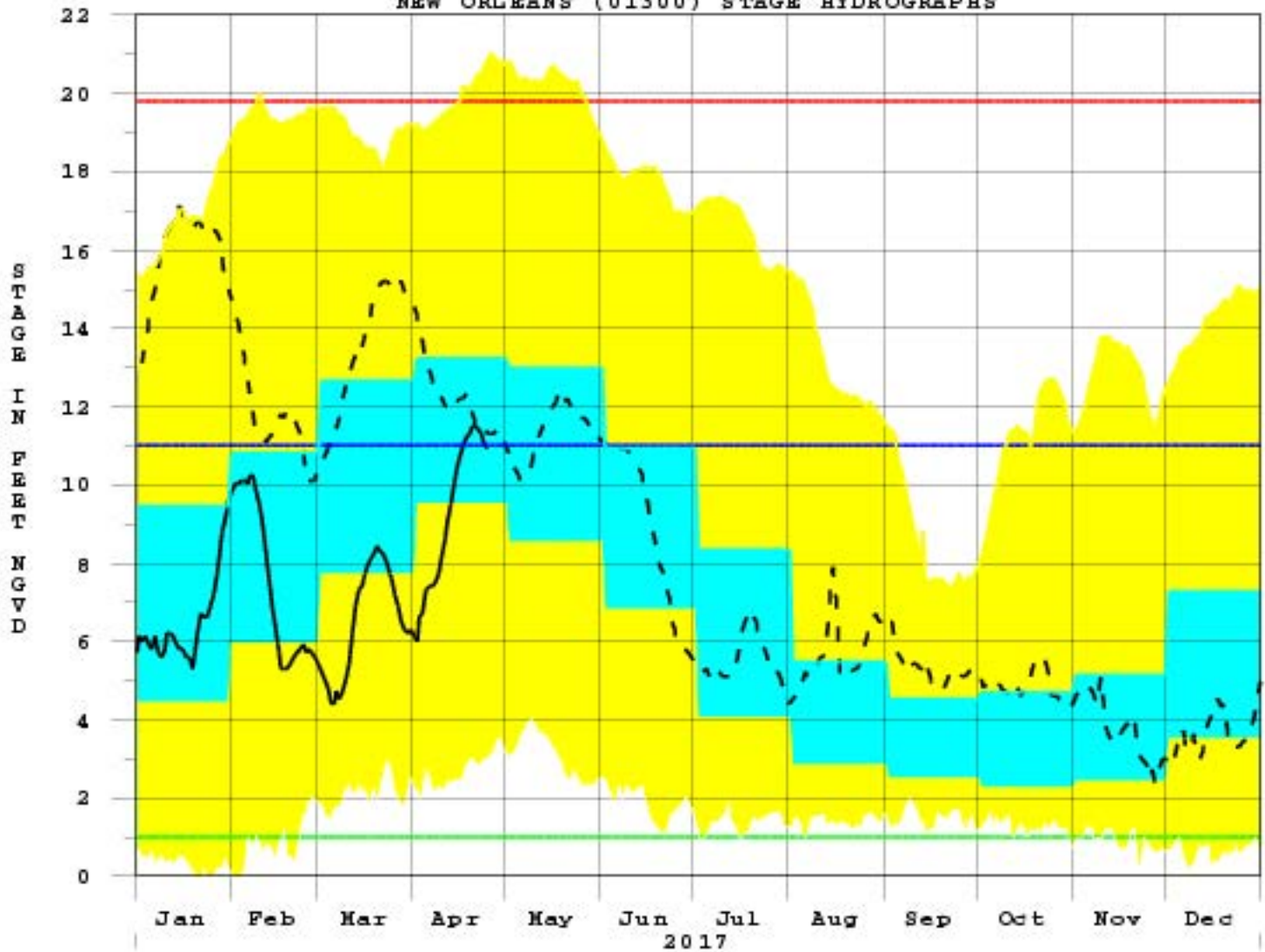
