The Contractor agrees to furnish all materials, labor,

that said Contract Documents impose duties and obligations upon
the parties herein, and said parties thereby agree that they
shall be bound by said duties and obligations.

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Time for Completion: The work shall be commenced on a date to be specified in a written order of the Owner and shall be completed within 120 calendar days from and after the said date. Contract shall begin no later than February 15, 2017 and end on June 15, 2017.

Compensation to be paid to the Contractor: The Owner will pay and the Contractor will accept in full consideration for the performance of the Contract the sum of: One Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$185,900.00).

Performance and Payment Bond: To these presents personally Came and intervened Scott C. Mahorsky, Attorney-In-Fact, Herein acting for Hudson Insurance Company, Organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, and duly authorized to transact business in the State of Louisiana, as Surety, who declared that having taken cognizance of this Contract and of the Construction Documents mentioned herein, he hereby in his capacity as its Attorney in Fact obligates his said company, as Surety for the said Contractor, unto the said Owner, up to the sum of:

One Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$185,900.00).

The condition of this Performance and Payment Bond shall be that should the Contractor herein not perform the Contract in accordance with the terms and conditions hereof, or should said Contractor not fully indemnify and save harmless the Owner from all costs and damages which he may suffer by said Contractor's non-performance or should said Contractor not pay all persons who have and fulfill obligations to Perform labor in the prosecution of the work provided for herein, including by way of example;

Workmen, laborers, and mechanics, machinery, and equipment, then said Surety agrees and is bound to so perform the Contract and make said payment(s).

Provided, that any alterations which may be made in the terms, of the contract or in the Work to be done under it, or the giving by the Owner of any extensions of time for the performance of the Contract, or any other forbearance on the part of either the Owner or the Contractor to the other shall not in any way release the Contractor or the Surety from their liability hereunder, notice to the Surety of any such alterations, extensions or other forbearance being hereby waived.

Contractor hereby agrees that the responsibility for payment of taxes from the funds thus received under this agreement and/or legislative appropriation shall be said Contractor's obligation and identified under Federal tax identification number 58-2642699-00

AFFIDAVIT

Before me, the undersigned authority, duly commissioned and qualified within and for the state and parish aforesaid, personally came and appeared Kerry Stafford representing Grillot Construction, LLC who, being by me first duly sworn, deposed and said that he has read this affidavit and does hereby agree under oath to comply with all provisions herein as follows:

PART I

Section 2220 of Part of Chapter 10 of Title 38 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 as amended.

(1) That affiant employed no person, corporation, firm, association, or other organization, either directly or indirectly, to secure the public contract under which he received payment, other than persons regularly employed by the affiant whose services in connection with the construction of the public building or project or in securing the public contract were in the regular course of their duties for affiant; and

(2) That no part of the contract price received by affiant was paid or will be paid to any person, corporation, firm, association or other organization for soliciting the contract, other than the normal payment of their normal compensation to persons regularly employed by the affiant whose services in connection with the construction of the public building or project were in the regular course of their duties for affiant.

PART II

Section 2190 of Part 1 of Chapter 10 of Title 38 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 as amended.

That affiant, if he is an architect or engineer, or representative thereof, does not own a substantial financial interest, either directly or indirectly, in any corporation, firm, partnership, or other organization when the architect or engineer has performed architectural or engineering services, either directly or indirectly, in connection with the public building or project for which the materials are being supplied.

For the purposes of this Section, a "substantial financial interest" shall exclude any interest in stock being traded on the American Stock Exchange or the New York Stock Exchange.

That affiant, if subject to the provisions of this Section, does hereby agree to be subject to the penalties involved for the violation of this Section.

PART III

That affiant does hereby state that he has read and agrees to comply with and be subject to the provision of Part V of Chapter 10 of Title 38 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, being Sections 2290 through 2296 of Title 38 as amended.
