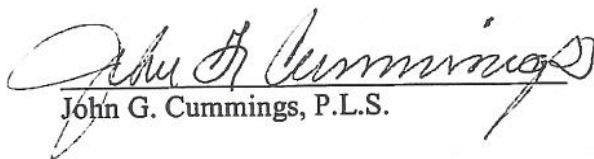
Dear Chuck,
