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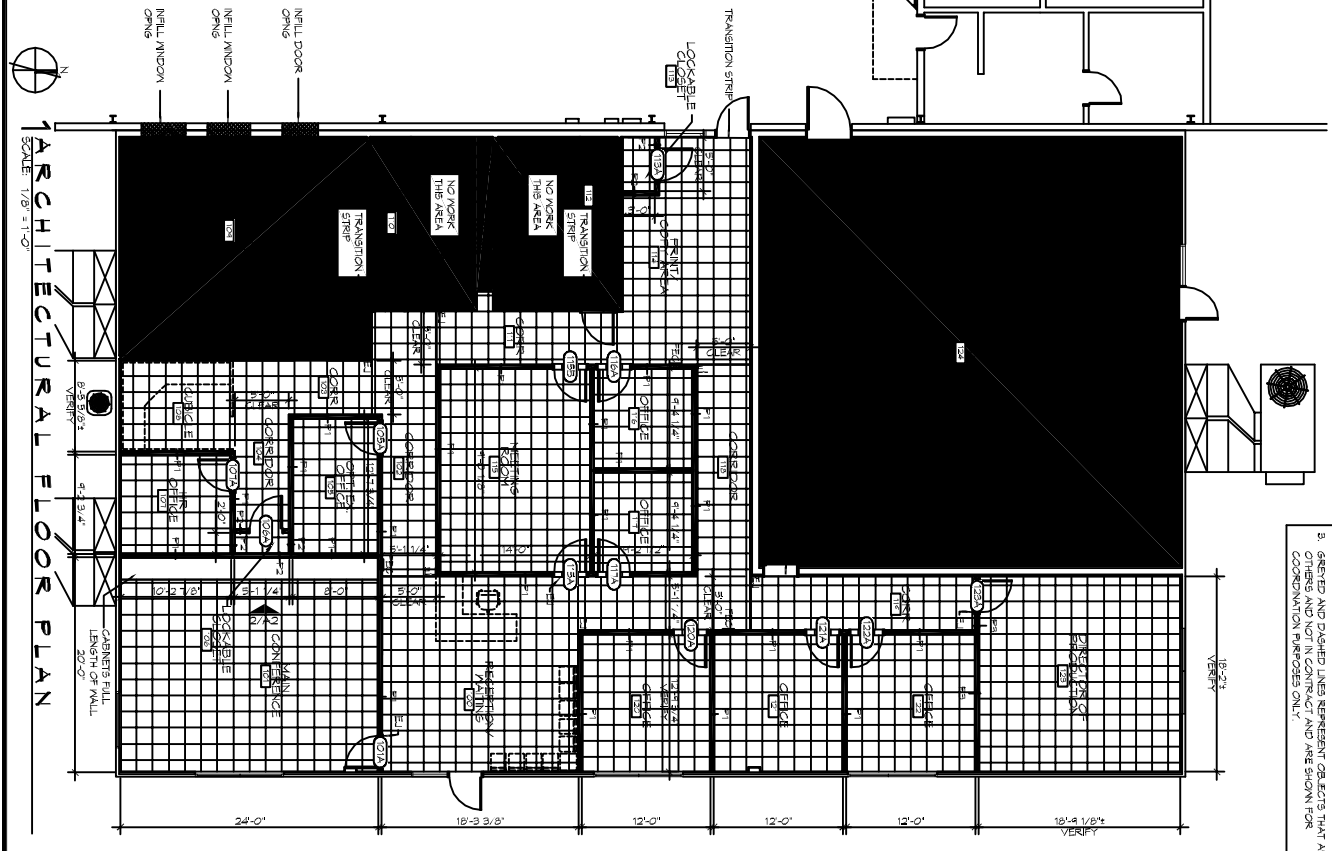
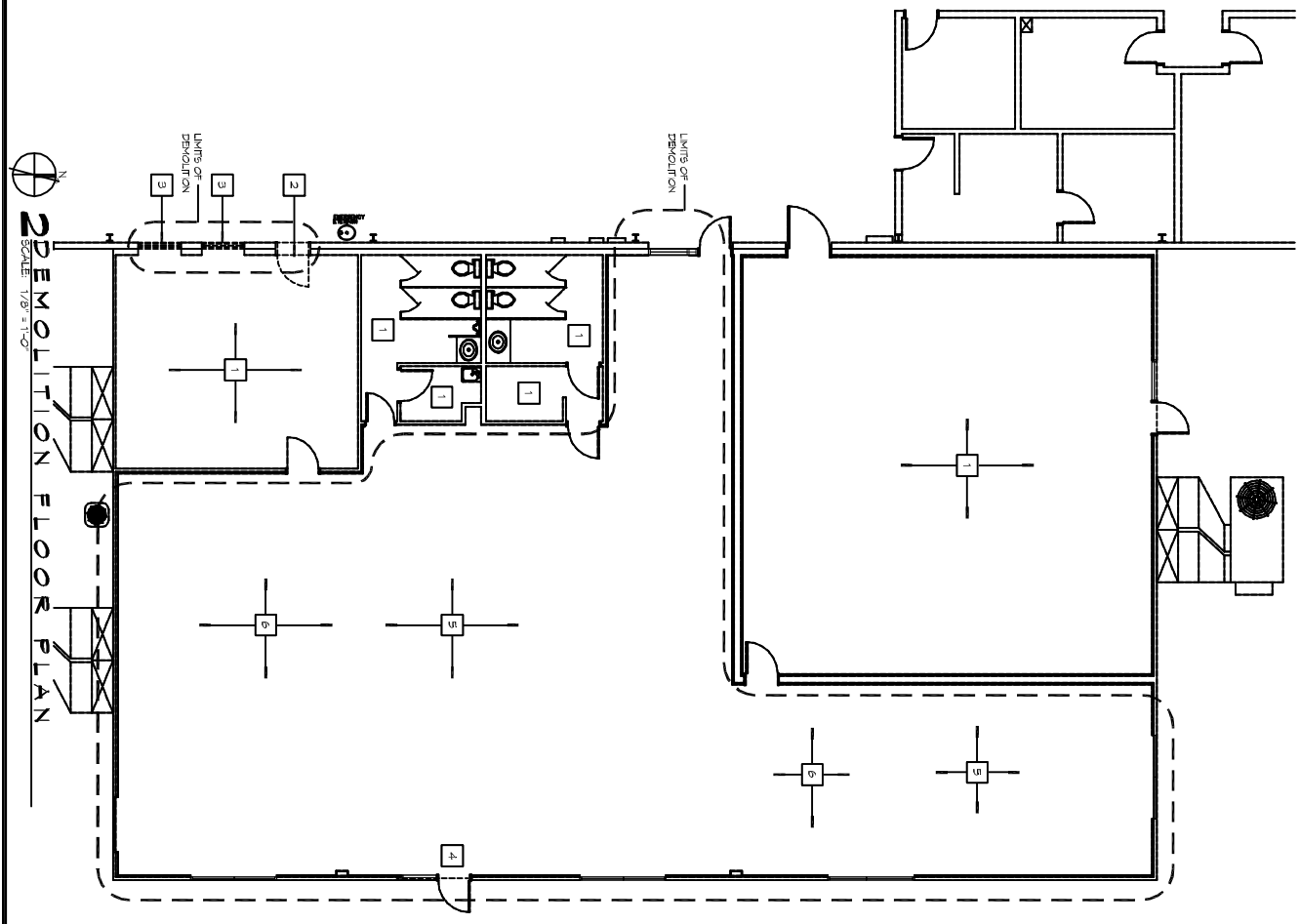
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GENERAL DEMOLITION NOTES

- DEMOLITION AS REQUIRED TO ACCOMPLISH WORK NOTED IN THESE DOCUMENTS. ALL REQUIRED PERMITS SHALL BE OBTAINED IN THE BID AND ALL DEMOLITION BID PACKAGES SUBMITTED BY THE CONTRACTOR.
- DO NOT ALLOW MATERIALS AND DEBRIS GENERATED BY DEMOLITION ACTIVITIES TO ACCUMULATE ON THE JOB SITE. REMOVE DAILY AND DISPOSE OF IN A LEGAL MANNER. NO ON-SITE BURNING OR BURNING OF REMOVED ITEMS IS PERMITTED.
- THIS PLAN IS TO BE USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE ENTIRE SET OF CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS. DO NOT REMOVE OR ALTER ANY PARTS OF THE DRAWINGS OR COORDINATING WITH ALL GENERAL NOTES AND TO NOTION THEY ARE PART OF THE CONTRACT.
- THE CONTRACTOR MUST TAKE ALL NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC AND/OR WORKERS ON THE SITE TO PREVENT ACCIDENTS OR INJURY TO ANY PERSON ON OR ADJACENT TO THE PREMISES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL LAWS, ORDINANCES, CODES, AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO SAFETY AND THE PREVENTION OF ACCIDENTS.
- THE CONTRACTOR MUST MAINTAIN ADEQUATE SUPPORT, INSULATION, WATERPROOFING, SECURITY, ALARMS, ETC. FOR ALL OR PART OF THE BUILDING AREAS TO REMAIN.
- DATA ON THESE DRAWINGS ARE AS ACCURATE AS PLANNING CAN DETERMINE, BUT ABSOLUTE ACCURACY IS NOT GUARANTEED. FIELD VERIFICATION OF THE PLANS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR TO FIELD VERIFY EXISTING CONDITIONS IN AREAS TO BE DEMOLISHED PRIOR TO BID. CONTRACTOR TO FIELD VERIFY EXISTING CONDITIONS IN AREAS TO BE DEMOLISHED PRIOR TO BID. - CONTRACTOR SHALL FINISH ALL EXPOSED ITEMS IN AREAS TO BE DEMOLISHED.
- CONSTRUCTION IN AREAS TO BE DEMOLISHED SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH THE OWNER PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION. EXISTING EQUIPMENT WILL BE RELOCATED OR STORED AS PER OWNER'S AND CONTRACTOR'S AGREEMENT. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROTECTION AND STORAGE OF MATERIALS TO BE STORED FROM DAMAGE IN LOCATIONS ACCEPTABLE TO THE OWNER.
- DAGED LINES ON DEMOLITION DRAWINGS INDICATE EXISTING MATERIALS TO BE REMOVED. EQUIPMENT TO BE REMOVED SHALL BE STORED AND PROTECTED FROM DAMAGE. ANY DAMAGE RESULTING FROM CONSTRUCTION WILL BE REPAIRED TO ITS ORIGINAL STATE.
- ITEMS TO REMAIN AND TO BE PROTECTED ARE DESIGNATED WITH CONTIGUOUS EXCEPT FOR HEAVY CONSTRUCTION. ITEMS TO BE REMOVED ARE DESIGNATED WITH DASHED LINES. CONTRACTOR TO FIELD VERIFY EXISTING CONDITIONS IN AREAS TO BE DEMOLISHED PRIOR TO BID. CONTRACTOR TO FIELD VERIFY EXISTING CONDITIONS IN AREAS TO BE DEMOLISHED PRIOR TO BID. PROVIDE THE FINISHED PRODUCT AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS. DISCREPANCIES SHALL BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE OWNER AND THE ARCHITECT FOR A DECISION TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS PRIOR TO BID.
- REPAIR WALLS DAMAGED BY DEMOLITION TO PROVIDE SMOOTH SURFACE WITH PATCH DIFFERED FLUSH, SMOOTH, AND READY TO RECEIVE FINISH MATERIAL. IF GYPSEUM BOARD BEHIND FINISH SURFACE IS UNREPAIRABLE FOR RECONSTRUCTION, REPLACE WITH NEW GYPSEUM BOARD.
- CONTINGENT DEMOLITION AND CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS WITH OWNER WHERE THE AFFECTED ITEMS ARE AREAS AND NORMAL OPERATING PROCEDURES.
- EXISTING TREES AND OTHER VEGETATION ON SITE ARE TO REMAIN. PROTECT TRUNKS, BRANCHES, AND ROOT SYSTEMS FROM DAMAGE DURING CONSTRUCTION.
- CONTRACTOR TO VERIFY ALL NECESSARY PERMITS ARE IN PLACE FOR THE PRESENCE OF TREES AND OTHER VEGETATION ON SITE. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROTECTION AND MAINTENANCE OF NEARBY VEGETATION AND OTHER AREAS TO BE DEMOLISHED.
- OWNER TO TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR RELOCATION OF EXISTING ELECTRICAL WIRING, BOARDS, CABLES, AND EQUIPMENT.
- SEE CIVIL DRAWINGS FOR SITE DEMOLITION INFORMATION.
