REGARDING THE ITEMS FOR DECISION:

WE ARE NOT SURE OF THE COST IMPACT OF A METAL ROOF THEREFORE WE WOULD LIKE THE BID TO CALL FOR COMPOSITION BUT INCLUDE AN ALTERNATE ON A METAL ROOF

THE HOUSING AUTHORITY WILL IDENTIFY THE BOOKS AND FOLDERS THAT SHOULD BE RETAINED. ANY BOOKS REMAINING AFTER THE DEADLINE CAN BE TOSSED.

RETAIN THE UPPER KITCHEN CABINETS AND SPEC NEW LOWER. AS WITH THE BOOKS WE WILL REMOVE ANY ITEMS WE WISH TO RETAIN.

WE WANT TO RETAIN ALL SHELVES WHERE POSSIBLE. IF THE SHELVES ARE GOOD WE MAY RELOCATE THEM TO ANOTHER LOCATION.

THE FENCE IS NOT PART OF THIS DESIGN CONTRACT AND SHOULD BE LEFT AS IS.

NOT SURE OF YOUR REFERENCE TO THE COMMUNITY ROOM. IF YOU ARE REFERING TO THE "BOARD" ROOM/ TRAINING ROOM" WE WOULD CONSIDER WINDOWS ON THE "EAST WALL"

WINDOWS FOR THE OFFICE SHOULD OF COURSE BE INCLUDED IN THE BID CONTRACT.

THE CONTRACT DESIGN IS FOR THE OFFICE ONLY.

FINALLY, REGARDING THE "NARROW" OFFICE : WE WANT TO RETURN TO THE ORIGINAL CONCEPT OF HAVING THE OFFICE AND WE THINK THE "L" SHAPED ARRANGEMENT WILL WORK.
