Dear Tara,

My client, Ro Marcello has decided to move forward with the re building of 227 Cousin St. However, all prior approvals submitted by my company, Destiny Builders, LLC and Ro Marcello that were approved by your departments must still be in place. The project as planned will be to re construct a single story commercial building on the existing foundation. The new structure will have approximately 6000 Square feet of commercial space available for lease as either a 2 tenant or single tenant space. As previously agreed, in order to keep the original architectural design we will use the existing bricks and metal awning.

We will commence construction as soon as the construction documents from our engineer and architect, The City of Slidell and the State Fire Marshall are stamped with the approval to move forward. I think that 30 days to submit final plans to the City of Slidell and 60 days for State Fire Marshall approvals as you requested should be reasonable.

We have removed all structures that were blocking the sidewalks on both Cousin St and 2nd St as of yesterday June 25th. I will submit for the preliminary building permit today and deliver to The Building Safety Department, final drawings within 30 days.
