Drawing look pretty good! Couple of things

1. I would like the Master Bath arranged the way it is on my drawing. The master bath will definatly need 2 sinks for resale and I think the tub looks better in the middle on the interior wall. I think a fixed window, perhaps the length of the vanity could be placed on the exterior wall. The entire vanity wall would be mirrored from the counter top up, say 4 feet, then the fixed window would be above that. Even with the higher counter tops this would leave room for a 1 foot or 18" high window.
2. AC is great in that corner or even better in the attic. Would we still need a return air vent in the corner loction?
3. I see why you have the window there. That is fine.
4. That is cool. We will take to Churck about the wall thickness.
5. I like the arrangement of the guest bath/closet.
6. Will also talk with Chuck about the covered deck area. I do think it would be better in the rectangular space off the master bedroom. The deck area off the office on the side could hold the AC, ect then an 8' deck walkway area on the front over to the enclosed area and then down on the side by the Master bath. That way the view from the entertainment area on the ground level would not be blocked.
