Joann,

I reviewed your email and would like to take a moment to address each issue you mentioned.

1. **Cancel appointment on Wednesday, June 6, 2007.** – Not a problem. We can communicate in whatever way is most convenient for you. I would like to fax you the changes if that would be okay, only because I believe that to be the fastest way for us to exchange information.
  - A. Your changes have in no way “put me out”.
  - B. You are our client – I have nothing but time for you.
  
2. **Windows**
  - A. Deciding on window size & shape does have to be decided at some point as it is the only detail left prior to moving on to construction documents. I need to know if it has a transom or not, if its round top vs. arched. The manufacturer and model number are not required, I am merely getting the size and shape for two reasons:
    - i. So that the window schedule and dimensions on the plans are correct.
    - ii. So that your elevations will be as accurate as possible.
  - B. If you would like me to stick a generic 18”x48” (or whatever dimensions you want) rectangular window in, I can certainly do that. All I need from you is what size, how many, and do you want them separate or mulled together. My apologies, I didn't realize when you wrote "3 radius windows, Jeld-wen clad wood CAEHC 24L60 or 24L50" or BCC2064-3" that it was merely a guideline and not specifically what you wanted. You are absolutely correct, you and your window guy should work on it as he can definitely tell you which windows can be mulled together and which cannot, and that will come after the plans are completed. Should you change the windows after the plans are completed, you would just need to let your framers know of the change and I'm sure they can accommodate you at that time.
  - C. Your window and door schedule will be derived from the floor plan, you do not need to "put one together". I have all of the sizes listed on the floor plan for your review next to each specific window or door. Our sizes are in feet/inches – so a door that says 2468 is 2'-4" wide and 6'-8" tall. Same goes for the window sizes. – If you just want to give me the size of the windows for now, and decide on the shape (round, broken arch, etc...) later, that is fine. I will need your final decision prior to drawing your elevations...I did not realize you didn't have your copy of the plans when we were speaking.
  - D. For the limited amount of communication we have had, I am pleased with the progress we have made on the plans. Other than the exterior look of your home, I believe we are just about finished. Your final approval on the floor plan is the only thing that is required. I believe we are on the same page on everything except the size and style of the few front windows.
  
3. **No sink in Utility room** – Not a problem.

I took the liberty of putting a different type of window on the rear elevation of you home prior to my leaving for vacation (you were in NY but I couldn't reach you). I will print it out for your review. Again, please contact me and let me know how you would like to proceed with the plans, either pick-up, mail, or fax. I will proceed in whatever manner is most convenient for you.
