The Office of Environmental Services received your request on December 10, 2020, for the above-referenced facility. Based on the information you provided, this facility will utilize a wastewater treatment system with spray irrigation to disperse treated sanitary wastewater. LAC 33:IX.2311.A.1 requires a permit for the discharge of pollutants from any point source to waters of the state. Land dispersal of treated effluent via a spray irrigation system that is approved by the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) is not classified as a point source discharge and does not require an LPDES permit to discharge. The facility currently has an active LPDES discharge permit, LAG536138. Therefore, once the sprinkler system is in place and an LDH certification is obtained, a RFT form (LPDES Request for Termination Form) must be submitted to terminate the existing permit.
