Ladies and Gentlemen:

Following are questions that have been submitted to date for the referenced project, followed by clarifications hereby made to the contract documents:

Project Plan Questions:

Q1. How much storage is required for Kitchen Equipment and who will accept delivery?

There are only two items that will be shipped prior to all of the kitchen equipment arriving, these two items are the hood system which is installed by the GC and the Oven which is provided and installed by the Other supplier. The remaining items supplied by Kitchen Equipment Contractor (KEC) will be accepted by a KEC representative. Remember that this shipment also includes items to be installed by GC, i.e. 1 and 3 comp. sinks, cooler, menu board, etc.

Q2. How involved is the electrician with the kitchen equipment?

The electrician shall make all final connections to the kitchen equipment, i.e. heat lamps, etc.

Q3. What type of cable is needed for the data and telephone connections?

The electrician shall pull cat 6 cables for computer and cat 3 for telephone all run to the telephone switchboard. Individual telephone home runs are not necessary from front counter to telephone switch, 1 pair per telephone outlet. Provide a conduit in wall from the ceiling cavity to junction box below at 48" AFF at telephone switchboard. Terminate data cables, Cat 6, on a patch panel, and terminate telephone, Cat 3, on a 66 block. Terminate all data cables using the 568B standard.

Q4. 5 additional cat 6 computer network cables are required. Two at front counter, one for the receipt printer and one for the bar code blaster. One at the driver's work space for box label printer. Two in the manager's hard office. See attached Rev 1 of E-1.

Q5. 2 additional cat 3 telephone cables are required. One in the manager's hard office and one at the delivery driver's station. See attached Rev 1 of E-1.
