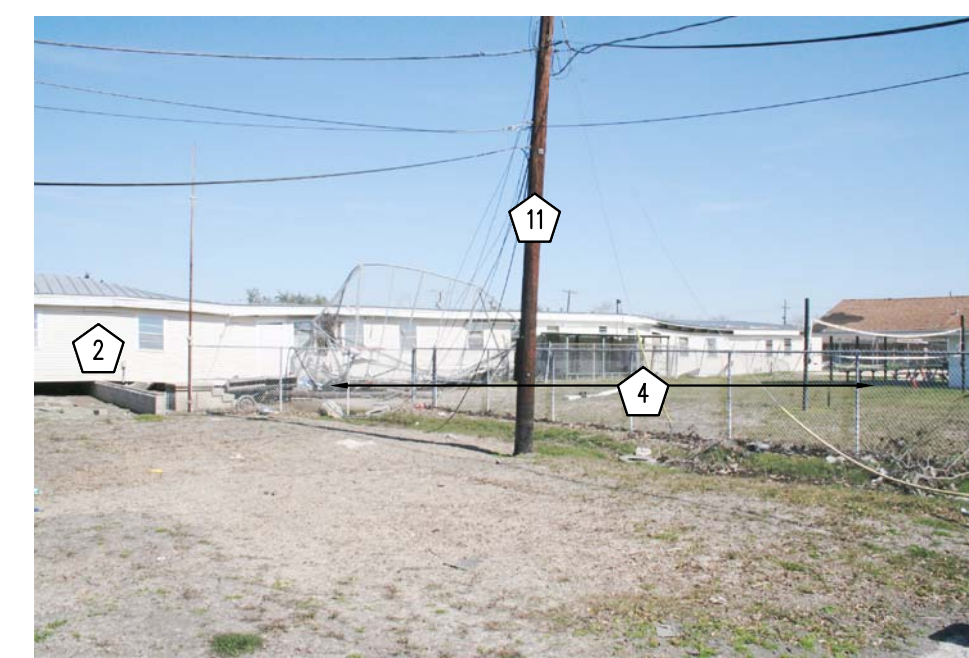

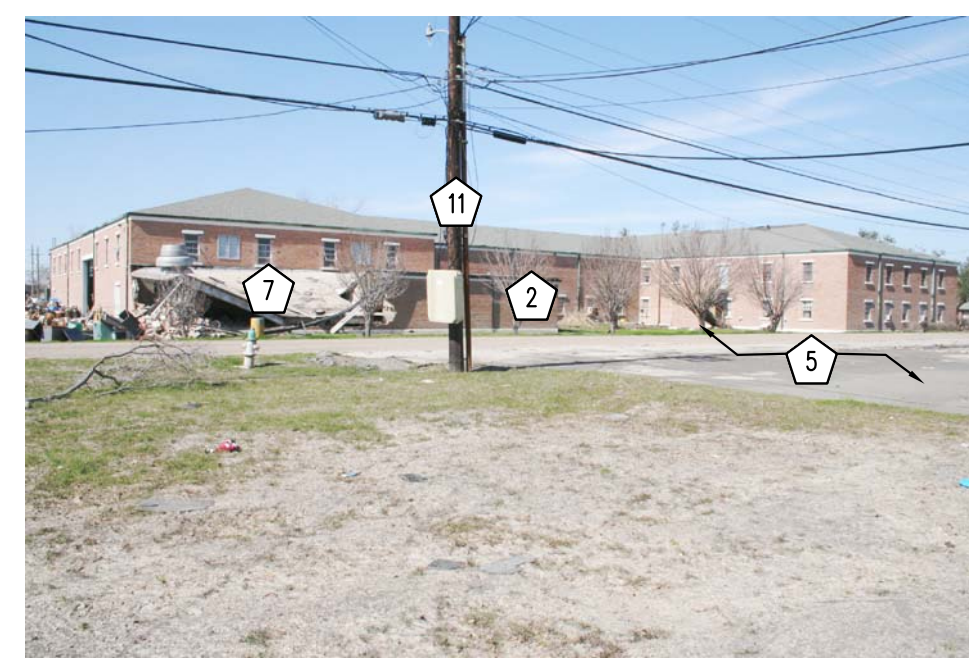

- CONTRACTOR TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROPER DISPOSAL OF ALL DEMOLITION MATERIAL. CONTRACTOR TO COORDINATE THE SALVAGE AND/OR REUSE OF ANY MATERIAL WITH OWNER.
- DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS TO INCLUDE DEMOLITION OF FOUNDATIONS AND ALL ABOVE-GROUND AND BELOW-GROUND UTILITIES (ELECTRICAL, WATER, ETC.) FROM BUILDING TO STREET CONNECTION.
- REFER TO ASH03 FOR LOCATIONS OF PHOTOS.
