### Week 12 Discussion Board

Just like we did with *The Sun Also Rises*, this week we will complete a Discussion Board on the novel, *The Book of Daniel*. We are going to follow similar guidelines, with a few changes. Like last time, I'd like your main post to be AT LEAST 600 words and address some facet, theme, technique, or analysis of the novel. Feel free to mix and match different ideas, as long as you cover enough to make a point. To add to this, I'd like you to try to reference AT LEAST one reading from last week where you see either a similarity or difference in theme or idea. You don't need to go into much detail, but try to incorporate at least one of the poems or the story into your response.

Also, as in previous weeks, respond to AT LEAST two posts from your classmates. To facilitate this, try to get your response done before the 11<sup>th</sup> hour, so that people can respond to your ideas. **The final date for submitting your DB post and two replies is next Wednesday, April 13<sup>th</sup>. Please adhere to this deadline, since anything turned in after this point will NOT be accepted.**

Your lecture on *The Book of Daniel*, including some notes on the poems last week, will be posted as soon as everyone has completed the quiz. It should be posted later today or tomorrow morning at the latest. Reading questions for this week will be included in the lecture.
