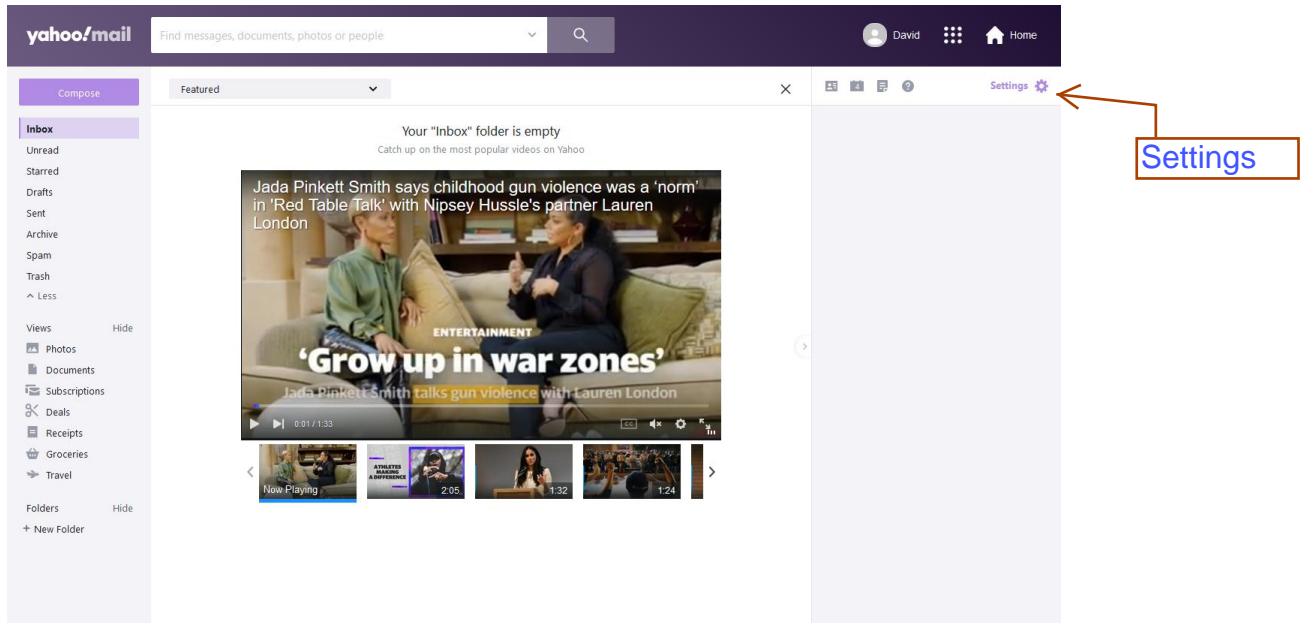
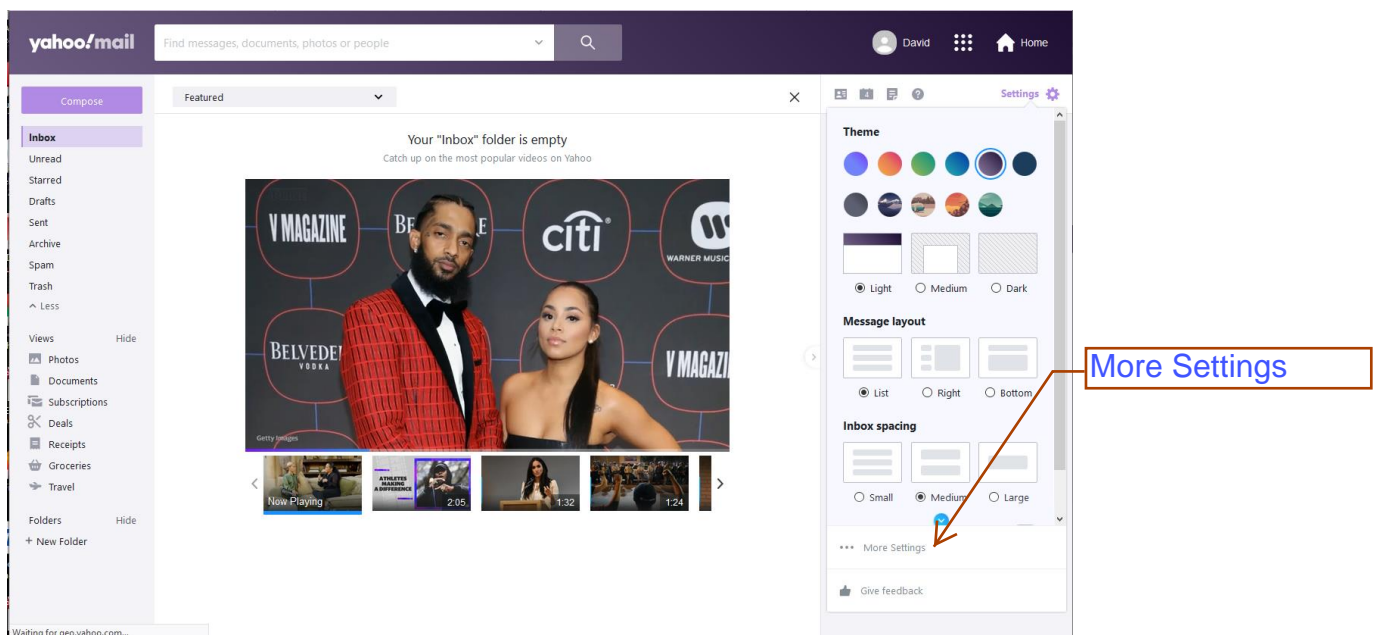


How to create a filter in Yahoo Mail

Open Yahoo Mail and look for the gear in the top right corner that says “Settings” and click on this.



Then look down the page and find where it says “More Settings” and click on this.



Then find the filters on the left
