Mr. Prasad,

Thank you for considering Dammon Engineering. We are pleased to propose our services for Material Storage Slab project in Bay St. Louis MS. This proposal does not cover the design for the Drop Weight Tear Testing Machine building.

Our understanding is that this agreement is for the structural slab for the material storage which will be approximately 40,000 square feet. This slab will store rolls of steel that have been off-loaded from barges. These rolls when stacked 2 high will exert a total weight of approximately 8,000 tons but not more than 400 pounds per square feet.

We propose a fee of \$12,600.00. A 10%, \$1,260.00, deposit will be required to start the project. You will be invoiced \$5,040 after the design is 50% completed and the remaining fee will be invoiced once the project is completely designed.

Our fee *does not include* the cost of project management, drainage studies, wetlands determination, or other engineering studies that may be required by government agencies *nor does it include* the cost of plan review or permits by the municipality. These items, if provided by Dammon Engineering, will be billed at a "cost plus" fee.
