Department of Veterans Affairs, SLVHCS New Orleans, LA is issuing this Sources Sought Notice to identify potential experienced small businesses for Architectural/Engineering (AE) services for South Louisiana Veterans Healthcare System (SLVHCS) Replacement Medical Center Project, New Orleans. This is not a solicitation, but a request for information from capable and eligible firms.

This project will consist of providing all material, labor, equipment and expertise for the following: Develop an art management program to coordinate the selection, acquisition, and installation of appropriate artwork pieces for the Replacement Medical Center being constructed in New Orleans. Following the program development, implement the plan and coordinate the outreach, selection, and acquisition of the artwork and arrange for and conduct the installation of the art in the medical center facility.

The AE selected will be provided the plans, drawings and specifications for the Replacement Medical Center. From those plans, drawings and specifications the AE will be requested to develop and implement the art program as stated above.

The project will be procured under NAICS Code 541990 "All other Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services under Small Business size standard of \$7.0 million.

Small business contractors having the skills and capabilities necessary to perform the stated requirements are asked to provide responses to this sources sought notice. Responses should include the following information: (1) Company name, address, point of contact with phone number and e-mail address; (2) Business size determination and qualifying small business status; (3) Experience of similar projects in size (artwork integration for approximately 1.4 million GSF), location (Southern Louisiana) and scope (artwork services for large complexes) "provide a minimum of three examples including fee value awarded; (4) location "provide proximity to New Orleans and examples of work done within the Southern Louisiana area.
