Dear Mr. Dammon:

Our firm represents Autodesk, Inc. (“Autodesk”) in connection with its investigations of possible unauthorized duplication and/or unauthorized use of its proprietary software products. We regret needing to send you this correspondence during such uncertain times and while you might be working remotely or with limited staff. If you are not already aware, Autodesk has initiated many efforts to help its customers manage their business during this pandemic; you can learn more about these efforts here: <https://adsknews.autodesk.com/views/covid-19> and visit the Autodesk Covid-19 Resource Center here: <https://www.autodesk.com/covid-19/resource-center>.

We are writing you because we have been advised that Dammon Engineering, Inc. (“Dammon Engineering”) may have unlicensed Autodesk software, including Autodesk® AutoCAD® software, installed on its computers.

It is possible that Autodesk’s records may not reflect Autodesk software products that are licensed but unregistered or that are registered to an individual within an organization rather than the organization itself. If this is the case, please send me the serial number for each such license of Autodesk software that Dammon Engineering currently has installed on its computers.

We wish to emphasize that this investigation is preliminary in nature. As we are sure you understand, Autodesk must investigate all credible information it receives regarding possible improper duplication and/or unauthorized use of its software products.


Please conduct your own investigation and determine whether improper software duplication and/or unauthorized use of Autodesk software may have occurred at Dammon Engineering. Please include in your investigation an audit of all Autodesk software products on all of Dammon Engineering’s computers (including, without limitation, each terminal, personal computer, server, workstation, and every machine capable of accessing or using such software) and proofs of purchase for each license installed. We respectfully request your response by July 7, 2021.

In addition, do not purchase or enter into negotiations to purchase any Autodesk software product prior to the resolution of this matter. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Nothing in this letter should be construed as any limitation, waiver, acquiescence, relinquishment, or election of rights or remedies Autodesk may have to assert, all of which Autodesk expressly reserves.
